You must confirm your place with the club prior to the course starting – numbers are strictly limited so we cannot accommodate people on the day. Our courses are very popular and often oversubscribed.

The course consists of 6 sessions of approximately 2 hours each which take place over a six week period. If it is necessary to cancel a session due to bad weather then it can be made up later. So please, when accepting a place on a course you must be sure you are available to attend all 6 sessions. We cannot accept beginners into the Club unless they have attended a full course.

Cost

The fee for the full course is £40.00 Adults £20.00 juniors, which must be paid at the start of the first session.

Juniors

We allow juniors of age 10 years and above to apply to join the beginner's course. However, acceptance of each junior on the course is subject to the approval of the coach. **Juniors that are not KEVICC students aged 10 – 16 must be accompanied by parents, or parentally approved guardians, at all times when at the archery club.**

Equipment

We provide all the equipment for the course. Please, **do not buy any equipment** yourselves. If you join the club after the course, we can offer advice to help you purchase your own equipment.

Clothing

You should wear comfortable but close-fitting clothing. If it's chilly it's better to wear several thin layers rather than one bulky one and perhaps bring a woolly hat. In particular it's important that you don't wear jumpers or jackets with baggy sleeves as bow strings tend to catch on them and spoil your shot. Similarly long hair may need to be tied back and nose, ear, eyebrow etc. piercings removed for safety. Please wear suitable footwear i.e. not open sandals etc. It is also a good idea to bring a drink too.

Where

The Totnes Archers shooting range is located at KEVICC, Ashburton Road, Totnes TQ9 5JX

At the far end of the School there is a large sports hall, the sessions will all be run in this building when the weather or light is bad, at other times we are on the main sports field (Access to the hall gained, through the main white door.)
